ELEVATING RISK MANAGEMENT

Since the onset of Covid-19, 44% of CPOs have accelerated their risk management programmes*. With the potential economic downturn to come, plus the continued threat of Covid-19, procurement teams will increasingly invest in new technologies to mitigate risks and ensure availability of goods.
